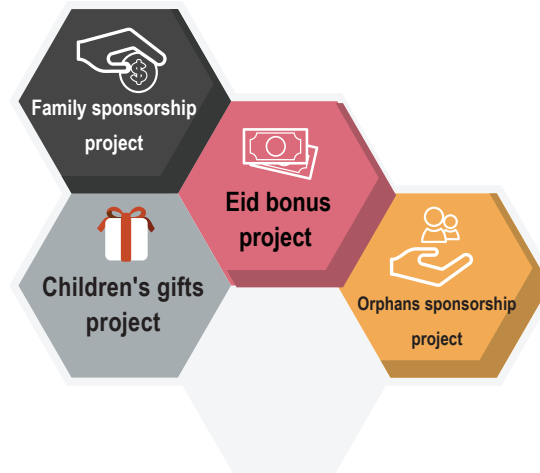

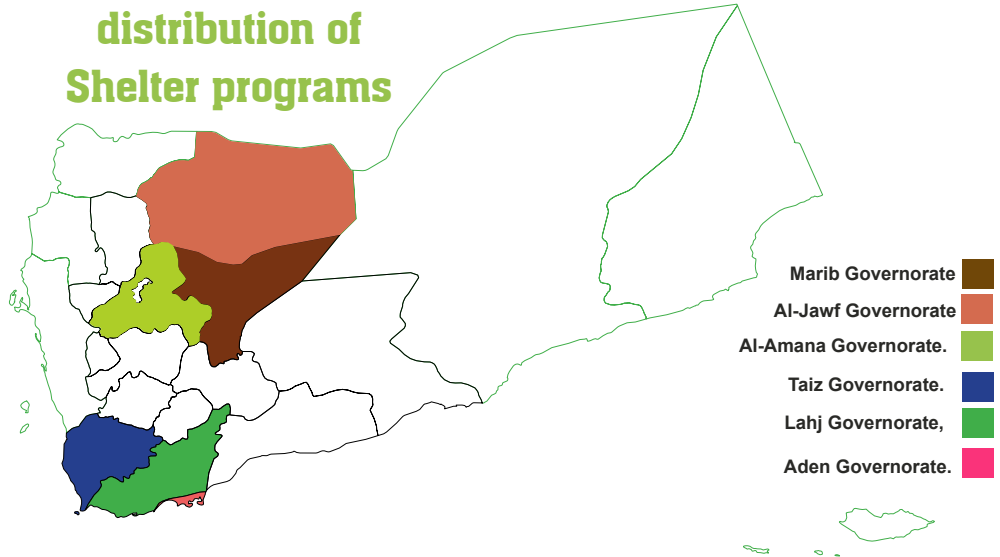

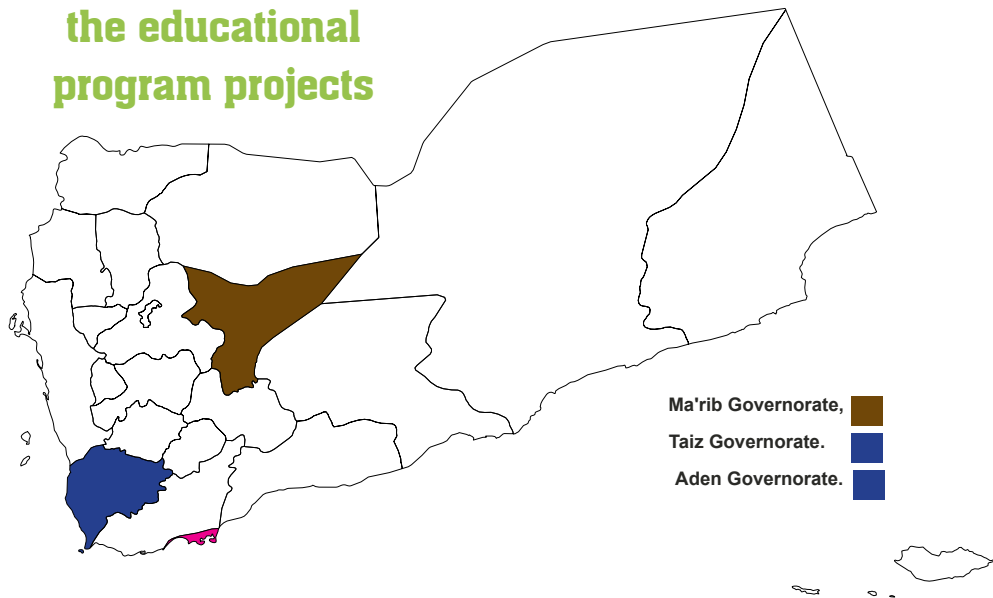

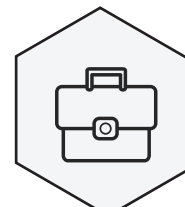
Geographical distribution of the educational program projects

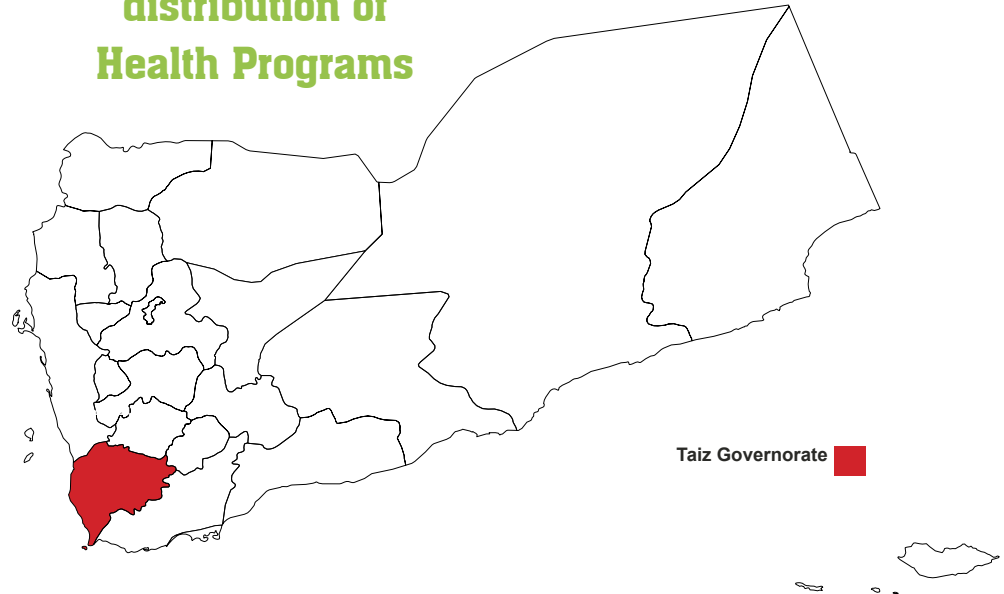

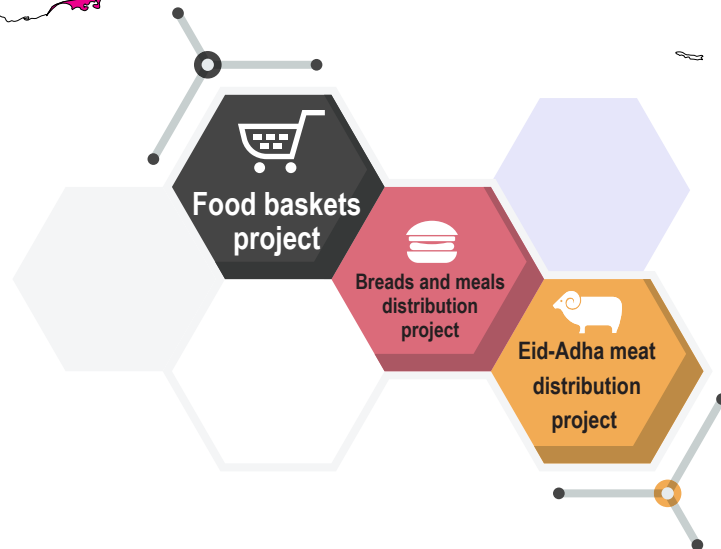

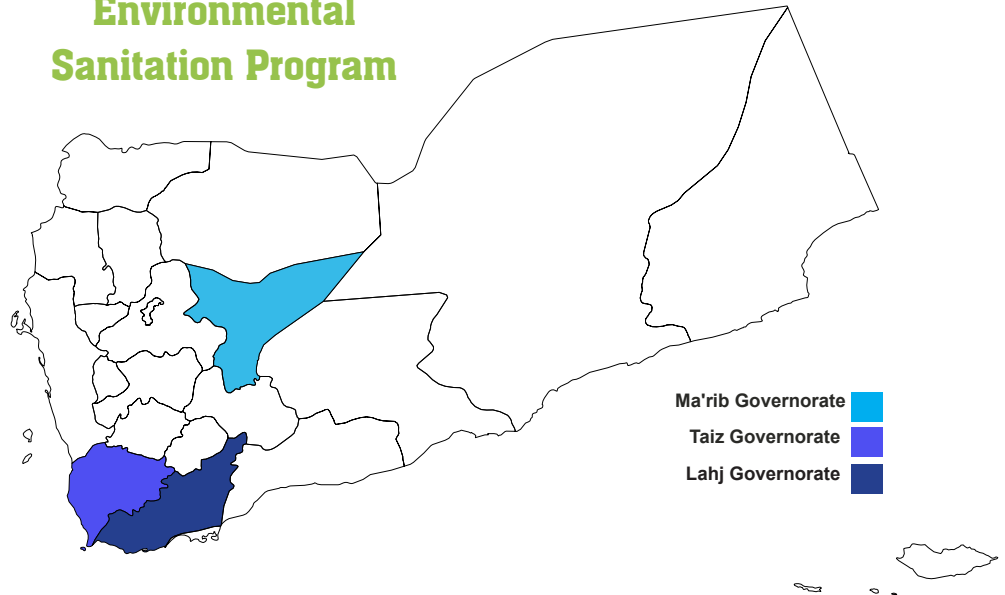

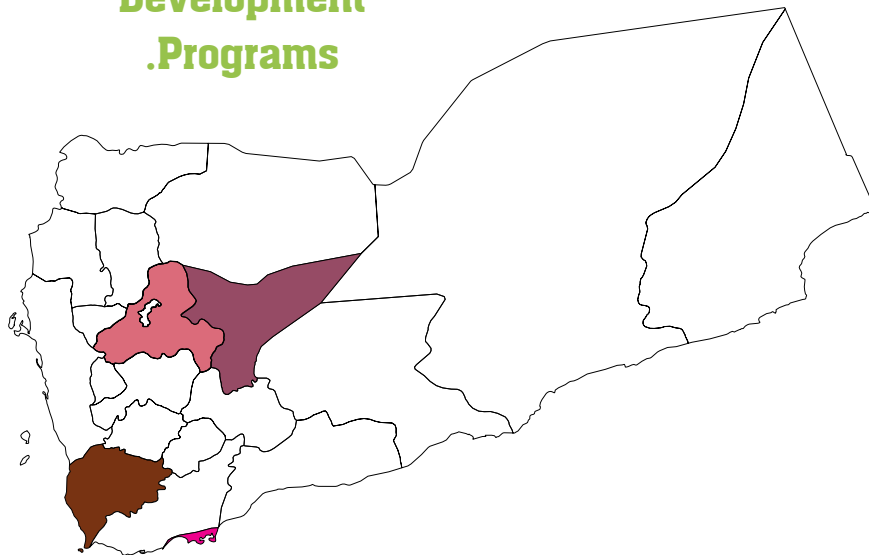
